MATCHBOX, THE ITINERANT ART AND CULTURAL PROJECT IN THE METROPOLE REGION OF THE RHEIN-NECKAR. AND S-BAHN RHEINNECKAR ARE SEEKING INNOVATIVE ARTISTIC PROJECTS

Matchbox and the S-Bahn RheinNeckar are initiating a joint artistic project along the track in the Neckar Valley in Baden-Wuerttemberg and Hesse. With "NextStop:Matchbox" we are inviting artists to develop innovative formats, performances and interventions that should invite participation both on the street cars and along the track that connects a host of villages and people within the region.

"NextStop:Matchbox" is focusing on the track along the Neckar Valley (from Heidelberg to Mosbach) and its suburban trains as the connective element for people and villages in the area. This mobile space is host to the people of different communities in the region on a daily basis and thus offers diverse audiences for artistic interventions and performances as well as an ideal platform for unusual formats of art.

WHO AND WHAT ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

- Artistic projects of all genres (literature, music, theatre, performing arts, painting drawing and sculpture, film, photography, architecture etc.), that understand and use the trains and carriages as an innovative space or stage. Projects should make use of in-train spaces or potentially use the surrounding possibilities within stations, communities and nature along the track.
- o Innovative projects that invite participation and:
 - That use in-train spaces as setting or stage and promote communication and exchange of ideas amongst commuters.
 - That turn known venues into unknown ones, thus providing the region's people with a novel point of view of familiar spaces (their squares, their local trains, their co-commuters, their stations, etc.).
 - That understand commuters and residents as collaborators and activate their own artistic social actions or their participation.
- Artists who are willing to discover the specific possibilities in the region of the Neckar Valley and who are prepared to live in one of the local communities from September to October 2016 and involve locals in their projects.

The following parameters are to be considered in developing project ideas on the stage of the S-Bahn trains:

- Projects should not rely on the use of a particular carriage or train, but should be flexible enough to be usable in various vehicles. Materials used should therefore be mobile (the reason for this is that carriages are used across the train net, and no single train or carriage is in constant and invariable use on the track of the Neckar Valley).
- Changes to interiors or exteriors of the trains need to be easily installable and removable and cannot necessitate changes to the existing structures.



WHICH FORMAL GUIDELINES ARE GIVEN?

Proposals for projects should....

- Not exceed 5 pages (including estimated cost and short biographies of participants)
- o Not exceed a financial benchmark of max.: 10 000 € (to include materials, travel and accommodation)
- o Include plans for project presentation on May 17th to 19th and consider September 26th to October 15th as given time frame for the realisation.
- o Be submitted by April 28th 2016 in German or English at: matchbox@m-r-n.com.
